National Immunization Awareness Month Information for Senior Citizens

August is National Immunization Awareness Month! The Ruby Valley Hospital and the Center for

Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) would like to take this opportunity to inform seniors and

other Medicare recipients that many important vaccines are covered by Medicare Part B, particularly

seasonal influenza, pneumococcal and hepatitis B immunizations. The CMS describes the Medicare

Part B benefits for these preventive immunizations as follows:

Seasonal Influenza Immunization: Medicare covers one seasonal influenza virus vaccine per

influenza season; a beneficiary could get more than one seasonal influenza virus vaccination

in a 12-month period. Medicare may cover additional influenza vaccinations, if medically

necessary.

Pneumococcal Immunization: Medicare generally covers the pneumococcal vaccination

once in a lifetime for all Medicare beneficiaries. Medicare may cover additional vaccinations

based on risk or uncertainty of beneficiary pneumococcal vaccination status.

Hepatitis B Immunization: Medicare covers the hepatitis B vaccinations that are reasonable

and necessary for the prevention of illness for those individuals who are at high or

intermediate risk of contracting hepatitis B virus.
